To ensure annually we are obtaining written verification from the FAA verifying the validity of certificates for no accident, incident or FAA enforcement action pertaining to Perform Air International certificated mechanics.

- 5.1 January of each year the list of current certificated mechanics listed in VII Supplement Log SL.05 shall be checked.
- 5.2 The name and license numbers of said certificated mechanics shall be checked on the FAA authorized portal at <a href="https://aie-pa.faa.gov/pa">https://aie-pa.faa.gov/pa</a> and written verification obtained.
- 5.3 The Human Resources Department shall keep a copy of the report in its records for viewing or inspection by authorized persons.
